6. Allotment Gates & Hose Pipes -

- A) Cllr Jenkins would like to propose that the allotment gates are unlocked, as soon as a disclaimer sign is erected stating that HPC accept no responsibility for loss or damage to equipment. **To resolve the above.**
- B) Cllr Jenkins would like to propose that if there is an increase in fly tipping then the gates are to be reviewed- **To resolve the above**
- C) Hose pipes- The Clerk informed Cllr Jenkins that in all the seventeen years as Clerk there has always been the no hose pipe rule. After the Allotment officer met with some tenants (Socially distance) it seems that hose pipes are used on a regular basis at some sites. At Purton there is only one tap and Sanigar there is only three, Brookend have more, so if this proposal is agreed, Tenants will need to respect each other when using the tap, and Tenants will not leave any hoses pipes permanently fixed to a tap. Cllr Jenkins would like to propose that hose pipes can be used, but if we have complaints then it is reviewed again. **To resolve the use of hose pipes.**

7. Fencing of the play area- Cllr Jenkins would like to look into quotes for closing of the play area from the back of the tennis courts to the railway fence. This will then make it illegal for dogs to be in the Play Area.

8. Fastershire/Gigaclear- Cllr Fryer would like the Clerk to contact the contractors and ask for the area opposite the co-op corner be put back to its original state.

9. Finance Committee-

- A) The finance committee would like to recommend to Full Council that the halfpipe is removed and replaced with the equipment from the half-moon. This will then give the Council time to apply for funding (if they wanted to) to help purchase a new piece of equipment. (price in Sept 2020 £4000.00 Inc. Vat, Clerk chasing up confirmation of any price change)- **To resolve the above recommendation.**
