8. Half pipe- It was agreed in April 2021 to remove the half pipe and replace it with the items from the Half-moon. Members of the council have tried to repair and remove it but the halfmoon equipment cannot be moved due to the age of the equipment. The Clerk has received a quote to remove the halfmoon equipment as well as the halfpipe £750.00 + Vat.

10. Christmas Tree –

A) Cllr Birnie would like the Council to re investigate the provision of planting a rooted community tree on the land near the allotments. Cllr Birnie recently spoke to the foreman of Gigaclear and he provided him with copies of his ground survey for the vicinity of the allotments/church. Cllr Birnie believes that was the only issue hindering planting a Christmas tree.

We know that Phillip is looking into extra fencing, but the present fencing and gates need to be repaired or improved.

Cllr Birnie has looked on eBay and found gate closers for under £10 and multi strand fencing cable for under £20.

Cllr Birnie would be willing to buy and fit the gate closers and with a bit of help he believes we could make the damaged fencing effective.
