1. **Apologies and Absence-** Received from District Cllrs Wride & Jones.
2. **Declarations of Interest-** None received.
3. **District & County Councillor reports-** BT gave a report on Child services, Lenghtmans scheme. Also, the highways local grant has been spent for this year. Wanswell lights are hopefully working now after numerous complaints. Councils can ask for a speeding vehicle to come to parishes if issue with speeding.
