Open Forum- PCSO Mike Trebble said that crime in Hinton is down. 2017- Jan -Dec 31 crimes 2018 – Jan-Dec 24 crimes in Hinton. In 2017 there were 4 burglaries, none in 2018

2. **Declarations of Interest-** Cllr Fryer declared a possibly interest on item 8
3. **District & County Councillor reports-** B Tipper gave a report on the incinerator budget, and the GCC budget. Cllr Reynolds asked if the road near the new development in Berkeley can be cleaned, Cllr Cooke asked if a sweeper can come and clean the bypass, and Cllr Marsh asked if there was any news on eh pot hole new Howard Tennes. 8. **Litter Pickers-** Cllr Fryer would like the Council to purchase some little pickers as there are a group of people who are willing to litter pick. Clerk advised the Council that a list of volunteers will be required for insurances purposes. **Clerk to investigate the insurance risk further.**
9. **Half Moon-** The current tenant has until March 31st to use the half- moon. A new vendor has come forward but cannot use the site without the PC permission.
