FULL COUNCIL MEETING

Minutes of the **Full Council meeting** held via Zoom (Virtual Meeting) due to Covid 19 on **Tuesday 16th June 2020** at 7.00pm.

Before the meeting started the Council were informed of Cllr Richardson resignation.

1. **Apologies and Absence-**Apologies received from H Jones (District) & Cllr Cooke. Cllrs Reynold & Brown were noted as absent.
2. **Declarations of Interest-** None received.
3. **District & County Councillor reports.** The Council received reports from the Cllrs, including lots of complaints regarding traffic at Purton, discretionary grant for small businesses closing date 21st June, Covid volunteer number, masks available for a small donation outside 2 sites in Berkeley, be nice if someone in Sharpness could do this. Drs are still open and are doing telephone consultations. The Local plan is still happening in the background. Taites Hill will be resurfaced in July
4. **Minutes from the last meeting held May 19th 2020 (ACM)** were taken as a true account, DB proposed this LF 2nd.
5. **Committee meetings-** The Council noted the minutes from the Finance & Planning meeting held on the 2nd June 2020.
6. **Cllr Richardson's Discussion – Lack of facilities in Purton** -Cllr Richardson had sent an update on the items he asked to be discussed. District and County joined in this item. Lack of facilities in Purton- Cllr Richardson had spoken to the local CRT manager and informed him of all the issues and how we could try and form a positive relationship going forward with all the issues at Purton. The Local manager will contact the Council directly.

Missing Sign at Hinton-The Clerk will ask for a list of signs that Highways are responsible for, if they are responsible for the sign in question, they will replace the old one, if parishioners put it there then they will not.

6. **Cont'd Purton Issues-** The increase of traffic in Purton is causing a huge problem, BT said if they are parked legally then there is not a lot anybody can do.
7. **Allotment re-Vamp – Cllr Freeman-** would like to set up a small committee to look at allotment issues, to include re vamp the tenancy agreement & possibly look at bringing the allotment sheriff back. This will include ALL 3 sites. All agreed for LF & MD to come back to the next meeting with more information. Clerk mentioned that if a committee was set up, terms of reference would need to be set.
8. **Booster boxes-** After looking at the breakdown, Cllr Beard proposed that a donation of £250.00 is contributed to the boxes, MF second this. All agreed.
9. **Parking bays at Gloucester rd.-** People do not park properly, you can only get three cars in the space, marking the bays out would make room for more. Parking is a big issue in the Parish. Perhaps the PCSO should pay a visit and see if there is anything he can do if people are parked illegally.
10. **Bonfires on Allotments –** After a lengthy discussion it was agreed by all with the NO BONFIRES until further notice. Council to review this when lockdown restrictions are eased more. People are still self-isolating. SDC have said that people should be recycling and composting as much as they can.
11. **Park Report -** Cllr Cooke was not in attendance, The Chair mentioned that he had, with the help of the Clerk and Mr Jenkins, erected some Tennis Court signs saying for “tennis only”, and they erected the dog bin back on the post.
12. **Clerks Report-** The Clerk updated Councillors on the repairs that had been carried out on the play equipment. This included new wood on the zip wire ramp and a new travelling unit on the zip wire, also the toddler swing was replaced, all these issues were in the Rospa report.
13. **Cllr's Report-** Councillors shared information around the table. Cllr Davey mentioned that somebody was training their dog in the church car park and didn't feel this was acceptable. Cllr Fryer thanked the Clerk for her continued hard work in these troubled times and for hosting the zoom meeting.
14. **Date of next meetings-** July 21st 2020. By Zoom if restrictions not lifted- Noted by all
